## Lack of data at granular level for decision making

- Programme, Field of Study (ISCED), AC units 1 & 2
- Bachelor of Arts (MH 101) and Bachelor of Science (MH 201)
  - 24 subjects across 3 faculties
  - ~over 45% of all first year UGs in MH 101
  - Up to 4 subjects = 100s of subject combinations
- Departments that only teach on MH 101



A high-level snapshot of student engagement and student experience for UG and PGT students






# Department & Programme Level Indicator Scores




### Questions relating to Higher-Order Learning

These questions explore the extent to which students' work emphasises challenging cognitive tasks, such as application, analysis, judgement, and synthesis




