Legislative Context - Monitoring

- □ <u>Legislation (Act 2012, amended 2019)</u> sets out the statutory functions of QQI
- □ QQI is required to (in summary)
- approve a provider's QA procedures and monitor and review the effectiveness of such procedures
- review and *monitor* validated programmes
- monitor the operation of the delegated authority (DA) to make awards
- monitor the implementation of procedures for access, transfer and progression in relation to learners by providers



Legislative Context - Monitoring

- ☐ Implementation of new statutory functions process implementation requires monitoring
- Authorisation to use the <u>TrustEd Ireland</u> quality mark
- Approval of <u>Listed Awarding Bodies</u> and inclusion of awards on the Framework
- <u>Due Diligence</u> capacity and capability regulations
- ☐ Requirements on providers
- Providers are required by the Act to assist QQI in the performance of its functions and provide any information (data, reports, documentation/other information) required by QQI ... including information in respect of completion rates
- Responsibilities on providers (DABs) to notify QQI of awards they make in the NFQ



- 1) Demonstrating compliance (range of functions)
- 2) Supporting public confidence in the NFQ (the awards within it and the providers offering programmes leading to these award)
- 3) Providing public transparency and accountability
- 4) Providing sector-wide trends and data
- Contributing to quality enhancement and quality culture
- 6) Enabling institutional benchmarking
